Pursuant to section 2 (4) of the Education Amendment Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Education (Chatham Islands Schools) Order 1979.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Commencement of section 2 of Education Amendment Act 1977—Section 2 of the Education Amendment Act 1977 shall come into force on the 3rd day of September 1979.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, as from the beginning of the third term this year, section 2 of the Education Amendment Act 1977, which brings the Chatham Islands within the Canterbury Education District, and consequentially brings Chatham Islands schools under the control of the Canterbury Education Board.
