THE EXPORT LICENCES EXEMPTION NOTICE 1966

PURSUANT to regulation 11 of the Export Licences Regulations 1966, the Minister of Customs hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Export Licences Exemption Notice 1966.

2. It is hereby directed that the Export Licences Regulations 1966 shall not apply to goods of the kinds specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. The declarations made by the Minister of Customs, pursuant to the Export Licences Regulations 1938, and dated the 7th day of December 1938*, the 1st day of March 1940†, and the 22nd day of October 1940‡, are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

GOODS EXEMPTED FROM APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS

Bona fide gifts to persons resident outside New Zealand.

Trade samples supplied without charge to persons resident outside New Zealand.

Goods being bona fide passengers' baggage and effects.

Goods being exported temporarily for repair and return to New Zealand.
