ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 13th day of March 1967

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Workers' Compensation Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1967.

**2. Rates of premium**—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) The rates shown in the said Schedule are expressed in pounds per £100 of wages:

“Provided that on and after the date of the commencement of Part II of the Decimal Currency Act 1964, the rates shall be taken as being expressed in dollars per \$100 of wages.”

**3. Scale of premiums**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the *Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 5*), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The *Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 5*, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations substitute a new scale of employers' liability insurance premiums for the old scale as from 1 April 1967.

In addition, the rate is now expressed in pounds per £100 of wages instead of shillings and pence per £100. The rate can thus be expressed as dollars per \$100 of wages without further amendment.
