PURSUANT to the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into effect one month after the date of their notication in the Gazette.
- 2. Conditions of distributor's licence—(1) Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) (as amended by regulation 4 of the Egg Marketing Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 9) the words "10 dozen", and substituting the words "15 dozen":

- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the words "5 dozen", and substituting the words "15 dozen".
- (2) Regulation 4 of the Egg Marketing Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 9† is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 14 of the principal regulations requires a wholesale distributor licensed by the Egg Marketing Authority to supply retailers, at wholesale prices,—
(a) On order, minimum lots of 10 dozen eggs; and
(b) On demand, minimum lots of 5 dozen eggs.
These regulations increase the minimum lots to 15 dozen in both cases.
