ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of June 1979

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL Pursuant to the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 15, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Increase in amount of entitlement levy—Regulation 75B of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 15 of the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 11) is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of the proviso to subclause (2) the expression "\$2" (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 13), and substituting the expression "\$3.50".
- 3. Revocation—The Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 13, are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase, from \$2 to \$3.50 a bird, the amount of entitlement levy that may be imposed in respect of each laying bird kept pursuant to an entitlement licence issued under the Egg Marketing (Production Entitlement) Regulations 1970 (S.R. 1970/236).
