**THE EGG MARKETING REGULATIONS 1940,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act, 1936, and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Egg Marketing Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Egg Marketing Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 12th day of June, 1944.

2. (1) Regulation 26 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By inserting, after paragraph (b), the word “ or ”; and by inserting after the said paragraph, as so amended, the following new paragraph :—

“ (c) Has failed, without reasonable cause, to comply with any general or specific directions, instructions, or rules given or made by or with the authority of the Minister for the purpose of ensuring the fair distribution to the general public of any eggs that may from time to time be available for such distribution ”.

(b) By omitting the words “ in either of such cases ”, and substituting the words “ in any such case ”.

(2) The powers conferred on the Minister by Regulation 26 of the principal regulations (as amended by the last preceding subclause) shall not be exercised with respect to any retailer on the ground that he has failed to comply with any direction, instruction, or rule referred to in paragraph (c) thereof unless, prior to his failure to comply therewith, notice of such direction, instruction, or rule was given to the retailer or to some responsible person or organization on behalf of the retailer or was published in a newspaper circulating in the district in which the retailer carries on business.
