PURSUANT to section 91M (1) of the Education Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Education (Extension of Application Period) Order 1996.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Extension of application period for payment of teacher salaries**—The application period referred to in Part VIIIA of the Education Act 1989 is hereby extended until the 1st day of January 1998.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force 28 days after its notification in the *Gazette*, extends from the end of 1996 until the end of 1997 the period during which the salaries of teachers employed at State schools will be paid in accordance with Part VIIIA of the Education Act 1989 (and staffing at most State Schools will be limited by Order in Council).
