PURSUANT to section 91M (1) of the Education Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Education (Extension of Application Period) Order 1997.
 - (2) This order comes into force on 1 July 1997.
- 2. Extension of application period for payment of teacher salaries—The application period referred to in Part VIIIA of the Education Act 1989 is extended until 1 January 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1997, extends from the end of 1997 until the end of 1998 the period during which the salaries of teachers employed at State schools will be paid in accordance with Part VIIIA of the Education Act 1989 (and staffing at most State schools will be limited by Order in Council).
