EXTENSION OF HEALTH ACT, 1920, THIRD SCHEDULE (OFFENSIVE TRADES).

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General.

Date on which the regulations were made: 15th day of December, 1936.

Date of notification in Gazette: 22nd day of December, 1936.

Pursuant to section 2 of the Health Act, 1920, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, hereby declare the following trades, businesses, manufactures, or undertakings to be offensive trades within the meaning of the said Act:—

The slaughtering of animals for any purpose other than human consumption.

Fish-cleaning. Carpet-beating. Wood-pulping. Flax-pulping.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act, 1936.
