ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Destitute Persons Amendment Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Enforcement of Maintenance Orders (South Africa and South West Africa) Order 1965.

2. It is hereby declared that sections 3 to 11 of the Destitute Persons Amendment Act 1963 shall apply to orders made, whether before or after the commencement of the said Act, in the Republic of South Africa or in South West Africa as if they were orders made in a Commonwealth country.
