ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Electricity Operator Order 1988.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.

2. Trans Power New Zealand Limited—Pursuant to section 2 of the Electricity Act 1968 (as amended by section 2 of the Electricity Amendment Act 1987), it is hereby declared that Trans Power New Zealand Limited is an electricity operator for the purposes of the Electricity Act 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 April 1988, provides that Trans Power New Zealand Limited is to be an electricity operator for the purposes of the Electricity Act 1968.
