PURSUANT to section 62 (1) of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1998, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Education (End of Old Enrolment Schemes) Order 1999.
- **2. Cessation of old enrolment schemes**—(1) In this clause, "old enrolment scheme" means an enrolment scheme that was in place under the Education Act 1989 on 18 December 1998.

(2) Every old enrolment scheme ceases to have effect on 31 December 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order fixes 31 December 1999 as the date on which "old enrolment schemes" cease to have effect. "Old enrolment schemes" are schemes that were in place when the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1998 came into force. The effect of the order is that after 31 December 1999, the only effective enrolment schemes are those made under the provisions of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1998.
