## EXPORTATION OF POTATOES.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Customs Act, 1913.

Date on which the regulations were made: 12th day of August, 1936. Date of notification in Gazette: 13th day of August, 1936.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section forty-seven of the Customs Act, 1913, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, doth hereby prohibit the exportation of potatoes from New Zealand save with the consent of the Minister of Customs.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act, 1936.

These regulations are administered by the Customs Department, except that applications for permits are made in the first instance to the Department of Agriculture at the port of intended shipment. (C. No. 157.)
