PURSUANT to section 4 of the Electricity Act 1992, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Energy, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Electricity Operator (Trans Power New Zealand Limited) Order 1994.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1994.

2. Trans Power New Zealand Limited to be electricity operator—It is hereby declared that Trans Power New Zealand Limited is an electricity operator for the purposes of the Electricity Act 1992.
