HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electoral Amendment Act, 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Electoral (Members of the Forces) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral (Members of the Forces) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding to Regulation 11 the following proviso:—

“Provided that nothing in this regulation shall prevent any member of the Forces who has not cast his vote in accordance with this regulation from casting his vote on the polling-day at any polling-place appointed under section 118 of the principal Act.”
