# THE EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES TRIBUNAL REGULATIONS 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 1

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 12th day of December 1983

### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Human Rights Commission Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Equal Opportunities Tribunal Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Equal Opportunities Tribunal Regulations 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1984.

- 2. Changes consequential on establishment of Proceedings Commissioner—The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting the word "Commission" in each place where it appears in regulations 3 (2) (a), 3 (3) (a), 4 (c), 8 (2) (c), and 11 (1) (c), and substituting in each case the words "Proceedings Commissioner".
- **3. Hearing**—Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

"(2) Where the aggrieved person is the plaintiff, the Race Relations Conciliator shall be given an opportunity to be heard either in person or by a person authorised in that behalf by the Conciliator, whether or not that person is a barrister or a solicitor, but shall not be a party to, or join or be joined in, the proceedings."

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 February 1984, effect amendments that are consequential on the coming into force on that date of the Human Rights Commission Amendment Act 1983.
