**THE EMPLOYMENT PROMOTION ACT REGULATIONS 1936,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 4th day of

THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Employment Promotion Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Employment Promotion Act Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Employment Promotion Act Regulations 1936\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.†
4. References to a declaration of income wherever they occur in the principal regulations shall be deemed to be references to the form numbered E.T. 55 in the schedule to the principal regulations as substituted by these regulations, including both Part I thereof headed "Declaration of Income other than Salary or Wages" and Part II thereof headed "Declaration of Industrial and Occupational Status".
5. The schedule to the principal regulations is amended by revoking the form numbered E.T. 55 set out therein, and substituting therefor the following form :—

NOTES.—(\*) For the purpose of this form and of the employment charge, the term “income” does not include compensation received under the Workers’ Compensation Act, 1922, pensions received under the War Pensions Act, 1915, or any other pension granted in Great Britain or within the British Dominions in respect of the Great War.

(†) Required only when the annual balance is on a date other than 31st March.

(‡) Declarations from farmers should be accompanied by form E.T. 58, except when a return of income is made under the Land and Income Tax Act, 1923, in which case this form should be enclosed with the “Income-tax return furnished.”

This form, together with the amount of employment charge payable, must be presented at any money-order office, or forwarded, postage paid, to the Commissioner, Employment Tax Division, Land and Income Tax Department, Wellington, C. 1.

When cheques are enclosed exchange must be added.
