THE EMPLOYMENT PROMOTION ACT REGULATIONS 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

PURSUANT to the Employment Promotion Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Employment Promotion Act Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Employment Promotion Act Regulations 1936* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.[†]

4. References to a declaration of income wherever they occur in the principal regulations shall be deemed to be references to the form numbered E.T. 55 in the schedule to the principal regulations as substituted by these regulations, including both Part I thereof headed "Declaration of Income other than Salary or Wages" and Part II thereof headed "Declaration of Industrial and Occupational Status".

5. The schedule to the principal regulations is amended by revoking the form numbered E.T. 55 set out therein, and substituting therefor the following form :---
