



THE ELECTRIC POWER BOARDS MEMBERS REMUNERATION DETERMINATION 1985

PURSUANT to section 214C of the Local Government Act 1974 (as enacted by section 16 of the Local Government Amendment Act 1985) and section 18 of the Local Government Amendment Act 1985, the Minister of Local Government, acting with the consent of the Minister of Energy (being the appropriate Minister) and at the request of the Electrical Supply Authorities Association of New Zealand (being an organisation recognised for the purposes of section 214c by the Minister of Energy), hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Electric Power Boards Members Remuneration Determination 1985.

(2) This determination shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1985.

2. Maximum remuneration of members of Electric Power Boards—The maximum remuneration payable to any member (other than the Chairman) of an Electric Power Board constituted under the Electric Power Boards Act 1925 shall be—

7,000 or over and not more than 20,000.....	24
More than 20,000.....	29

3. Revocations—The following regulations are hereby revoked:

- (a) The Electric Power Boards Remuneration Regulations 1978 (S.R. 1978/147);
- (b) The Electric Power Boards Remuneration Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1981/53).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which comes into force on 1 October 1985, increases the maximum remuneration of members of Electric Power Boards from \$9, \$14, and \$17 per meeting to \$16, \$24, and \$29 per meeting, depending on the number of consumers within the Board's district. The actual amount to be paid to members is to be determined within those limits by resolution of the Board under section 214D of the Local Government Act 1974.
