PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Electric Power Boards Remuneration Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electric Power Boards Remuneration Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 22nd day of April 1985.
- **2. Schedule**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Electric Power Boards Remuneration Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) The Electric Power Boards Remuneration Regulations 1978. Amendment No. 1 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for the payment of remuneration to members and chairmen of committees of electric power boards at new rates similar to those currently paid to members of other local authorities.
