**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

THE HON. H. G. R. MASON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Enemy Property Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Enemy Property Emergency Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to the definition of the term "alien enemy" in clause (2) the following proviso :—

"Provided that no woman being a British subject by birth shall be deemed to be or to become an alien enemy by virtue of any marriage entered into by her either before or after the commencement of these regulations :"

3. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.
