

THE ENEMY PROPERTY EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 9

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 26th day of May 1953

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Enemy Property Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Enemy Property Emergency Regulations 1939.*

2. Regulation 2 of the Enemy Property Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 8, is hereby revoked as from the 31st day of December 1952.

3. The said revocation shall not:

(a) Affect the validity or alter the effect of any licence granted under the Patents, Designs, Trade Marks, and Copyright Emergency Regulations 1940†; or

(b) Release any person from liability to pay to the Custodian of Enemy Property any income from copyright if the income accrued on or before the said 31st day of December 1952; or

(c) Give any person a right to receive a refund of any income from copyright paid to the Custodian (whether before or after the making of these regulations) if the income accrued on or before the said 31st day of December 1952.
