### THE ENEMY PROPERTY (JAPAN) NOTICE 1947

PURSUANT to the Enemy Property Emergency Regulations 1939, the Attorney-General hereby gives notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Enemy Property (Japan) Notice 1947.

2. This notice applies—

- (a) To any Government, public, or other authority in Japan :
- (b) To any person resident in Japan :
- (c) In respect of any business carried on in Japan, to any person or body of persons (whether incorporated or not) carrying on that business.

3. Permission is hereby given to—

- (a) Any assignment of a chose in action which on or after the date of this notice comes into the ownership of an authority or a person to whom this notice applies :
- (b) Any transfer of a negotiable instrument issued on or after the date of this notice :
- (c) Any transfer of any security transferable by delivery, not being a coupon or a negotiable instrument, which on or after the date of this notice comes into the ownership of an authority or a person to whom this notice applies,—

being an assignment or transfer made on or after the date of this notice by reason of any trade authorized by the Enemy Trading (Japan) Notice (No. 2) 1947\* by or on behalf of an authority or a person to whom this notice applies.

4. Consent and permission are hereby given to the payment and transfer to an authority or a person to whom this notice applies of—

- (a) Any money which would but for the existence of a state of war become payable to or for the benefit of an authority or a person to whom this notice applies on or after the date of this notice by reason of any trade authorized by the Enemy Trading (Japan) Notice (No. 2) 1947\* :
- (b) Any property which on or after the date of this notice comes into the ownership of any such authority or person as aforesaid by reason of any such trade as aforesaid.
