



**THE EDUCATION (FREE PLACE) REGULATIONS 1945,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of July 1956

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Free Place) Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Free Place) Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the words "obtained a Primary School Certificate", and substituting the words "completed a course in Form II".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations specify the completion of a course in Form II as the educational qualification for the award of a free place tenable at a secondary or technical school. The Primary School Certificate mentioned in the existing regulations is no longer awarded.
