Pursuant to the Electoral Act, 1927, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Electoral Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Electoral Regulations 1928* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").
- 3. Every application for a voting-paper made under section 3 of the Electoral Amendment Act, 1937, shall be in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto.
- 4. Clauses (4) and (5) of Regulation 13 of the principal regulations are revoked.
