ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 14th day of April 1975

PURSUANT to Part VI of the Health Act 1956 and sections 79 and 100 of the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Electroplating Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electroplating Regulations 1950\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. **Metric amendments**—The principal regulations are hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Schedule to these regulations.

## SCHEDULE

## METRIC AMENDMENTS

Regulation Amended	Amendment
5 .....	By omitting the words "500 cubic feet", and substituting the words "15 cubic metres".
	By omitting the expression "14 ft.", and substituting the words "4 metres".
8 (2) .....	By omitting the expression "1 ft.", and substituting the words "0.3 metres".
13 (1) (a) .....	By omitting the expression "2 ft.", and substituting the words "0.6 metres".
15 (2) (a) .....	By omitting the words "12 square feet", and substituting the words "1 square metre".
19 .....	By omitting the expression "10 ft.", and substituting the words "3 metres".
