#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. D. C. McKINNON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electoral Act 1956, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Electoral Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 11, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Regulations 1981\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 19th day of February 1993.
- 2. Application for registration of mentally incapable person—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking form 1A (as inserted by regulation 24 (2) of the Electoral Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the form 1A set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

- **3.** Inquiry roll revision—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking form 4 (as substituted by regulation 24 (9) of the Electoral Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the form 4 set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **4. Revocations**—Regulation 24 of the Electoral Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 8 is hereby consequentially amended by revoking subclauses (2) and (9).
