

# THE ELECTRICITY REGULATIONS 1993, AMENDMENT NO. 2

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1992, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Electricity Regulations 1993, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricity Regulations 1993\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1994.
- 2. Practising licences—(1) Regulation 12 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

\*S.R. 1993/75 Amendment No. 1: S.R. 1993/413 (2) Regulation 12 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words "Subject to subclause (3) of this regulation,".

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 March 1994, amend the Electricity

Regulations 1993.

The amendment revokes regulation 12 (3) of the principal regulations, which provides that no fee is payable in respect of any application for a practising licence made before 1 April 1994.
