PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1992, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Electricity Regulations 1993, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricity Regulations 1993* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1994.

2. Practising licences—(1) Regulation 12 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

(2) Regulation 12 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “Subject to subclause (3) of this regulation,”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 March 1994, amend the Electricity Regulations 1993.

The amendment revokes regulation 12 (3) of the principal regulations, which provides that no fee is payable in respect of any application for a practising licence made before 1 April 1994.
