HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency Reserve Corps Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Reserve Corps Regulations 1940\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "committee", "Home Guard", and "sub-committee".

3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) of clause (2).

4. Regulations 5, 6, 7, 7A, 7B, and 8 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked.

5. Regulations 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 of the Emergency Reserve Corps Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.
