

THE ELECTORS REGISTRATION ORDER 1957

Pursuant to the Electoral Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Electors Registration Order 1957.
- 2. The period within which every person qualified to be registered as an elector of any European or Maori electoral district must apply for registration under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 43 of the Electoral Act 1956 shall, in respect of the Proclamation made under section 19 of that Act on the 1st day of March 1957,* be the period of three months commencing on the 1st day of April 1957 and ending with the 30th day of June 1957.
