THE ENGINEERS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1951, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Engineers Registration Act 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the words "and may recognise any examination of the New Zealand Institution of Engineers if it considers that the standard of the examination is at least equal to that of the corresponding examination of the Institution of Civil or Electrical or Mechanical Engineers of the United Kingdom".
- 3. (1) Regulation 52 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall be £1", and substituting the words "shall be 10s. 6d.".
- (2) The form numbered E.R. 2 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "fee of £1", and substituting the words "fee of 10s. 6d.".
- (3) This regulation shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1957.

4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Form C, and substituting the following form: "[Form C Serial No. Engineers Registration Act 1924 Annual Practising Certificate 19.....–19..... This is to certify that who is a registered engineer, is granted this practising certificate under section 3 of the Engineers Registration Amendment Act 1944, and is thereby entitled to practise as a registered engineer for the year ending Registration No.: Date of Registration: Qualified under, Registrar." 5. The form numbered E.R. 1 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended-(a) By revoking paragraphs (a) and (b), and substituting the words "registration under the Engineers Registration Act 1924":
(b) By omitting the words "3s. stamp duty". 6. The principal regulations are hereby amended— (a) By revoking regulations 10, 21, 23 to 43, 49, and 54: (b) By revoking form B in the First Schedule: (c) By revoking the forms numbered E.R. 3 and E.R. 4 in the Second Schedule. T. J. SHERRARD, Clerk of the Executive Council. EXPLANATORY NOTE This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for minor amendments in the practice of the Engineers Registration Board; and revoke the provisions in the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951 relating to the conduct of engineering examinations. These examinations will in future be conducted by the New Zealand Institution of Engineers.
