THE ENGINEERS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1951, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Engineers Registration Act 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1967.
- 2. Registration fee—Regulation 48 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall be £1 1s.", and substituting the words "shall be £2 10s.".
- 3. Inspection fee—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 50, and substituting the following regulation:

"50. The fee for inspection of the register shall be 5s. for every name

in respect of which the entries are inspected."

4. Fee for certified copy—Regulation 51 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall be 5s.", and substituting the words "shall be 10s.".

- 5. Fee for annual practising certificate—(1) Regulation 52 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (1) of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "shall be 10s. 6d.", and substituting the words "shall be 15s.".
- (2) The form numbered E.R. 2 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (2) of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "fee of 10s. 6d.", and substituting the words "fee of 15s.".
- (3) Regulation 3 of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.
- 6. Fee for certificate of particulars in annual practising certificate—Regulation 53 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall be 5s.", and substituting the words "shall be 10s.".
- 7. Examination fee—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by inserting, after regulation 53, the following regulation:
- "53a. The fee for submission of a thesis shall be £10, and the fee for entry for an examination involving written submissions and an interview by examiners shall be £5."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the various fees payable under the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951.
