**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of December 1980

Present:

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Engineers Registration Act 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fee for annual practising certificate**—(1) Regulation 52 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (1) of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 4) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "shall be \$5", and substituting the words "shall be \$7".

(2) The form numbered E.R. 2 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (2) of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 4) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "fee of \$5", and substituting the words "fee of \$7".

(3) The Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 4, are hereby revoked.

These regulations increase the fee for an annual practising certificate payable under the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951 from \$5 to \$7.
