PURSUANT to the Engineers Registration Act 1924, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1992.

2. Fee for registration—Regulation 48 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951,

3. Fee for annual practising certificate—(1) Regulation 52 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (1) of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall be \$20", and substituting the words "shall be \$30".

(2) The form numbered E.R. 2 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (2) of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by omitting the words "fee of 20", and substituting the words "fee of 30".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1992, increase the fees for registration and for an annual practising certificate payable under the Engineers Registration Regulations 1951 from \$20 to \$30.
