PURSUANT to the Electricians Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Electricians Registration Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricians Registration Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 38, and substituting the following regulation:

"38. No fee shall be payable for supplying copies of past examination papers when available."
