**THE ELECTRICIANS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1956,

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 16th day of April 1962

PURSUANT to the Electricians Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Electricians Registration Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricians Registration Regulations 1956\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 38, and substituting the following regulation:

“38. No fee shall be payable for supplying copies of past examination papers when available.”
