## THE ENGINEERS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1945, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Engineers Registration Act, 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Engineers Registration Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1945\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. The principal regulations are amended by adding thereto the following headings and regulation:—

### "PART XIV

## "Engineering in Relation to Building

"70. Where an architect is retained for the design or erection of any building or of any work to be done on a building and such design, erection, or work amounts to engineering work within the meaning of subsection (4) of section 8 of the Engineers Registration Amendment Act, 1944, to which that subsection applies, then, subject to section 9 of the said Act, it shall be the duty of the local authority concerned to ensure that the architect arranges for the supervision of such engineering work by a registered engineer in compliance with the provisions of the said subsection (4)."
