**THE ENGINEERS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1945,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Engineers Registration Act, 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Engineers Registration Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Engineers Registration Regulations 1945* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. The principal regulations are amended by adding thereto the following headings and regulation :—

“ PART XIV

“ Engineering in Relation to Building

“ 70. Where an architect is retained for the design or erection of any building or of any work to be done on a building and such design, erection, or work amounts to engineering work within the meaning of subsection (4) of section 8 of the Engineers Registration Amendment Act, 1944, to which that subsection applies, then, subject to section 9 of the said Act, it shall be the duty of the local authority concerned to ensure that the architect arranges for the supervision of such engineering work by a registered engineer in compliance with the provisions of the said subsection (4).”
