**THE ECONOMIC STABILISATION (IMPORT DEPOSIT)
NOTICE 1976, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation (Import Deposit) Regulations 1976*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Import Deposit) Notice 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation (Import Deposit) Notice 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 30th day of July 1976.

2. Imported goods subject to the regulations—The principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from the First Schedule the Customs Tariff headings and item numbers and description of goods specified in the Schedule hereto.
