# THE ECONOMIC STABILISATION (CARLESS DAY STICKERS AND EXEMPT STICKER) NOTICE 1979

Pursuant to regulations 14 (2) and 20 (3) of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations (No. 2) 1979\*, the Minister of Energy hereby gives the following notice.

#### NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Carless Day Stickers and Exempt Sticker) Notice 1979.
  - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1979.
- 2. Carless day stickers—Every carless day sticker shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule to this notice and shall conform to the requirements set out in that Schedule.
- 3. Exempt sticker—Every exempt sticker shall be in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this notice and shall conform to the requirements set out in that Schedule.

1. The predominant colour of the front of each carless day sticker and the letter of the alphabet that immediately precedes the number to be shown on the front of each carless day sticker shall be as follows:

- 2. The colour of the letters denoting the day of the week specified on the front of each carless day sticker shall be white.
- 3. The number (including the immediately preceding letter) required to be shown on the front of each carless day sticker may in addition be shown (but is not required to be shown) on the back of the sticker.
- 4. The date of the issue of a carless day sticker may be shown (but is not required to be shown) on the back of the sticker.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 June 1979, prescribes the form of the carless day stickers and the form of the exempt sticker required for the purposes of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations (No. 2) 1979.
