## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 31st day of May, 1947

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 38 of the principal regulations (as substituted by Regulation 5 of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 4, and amended by Regulation 3 of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 5) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "but, except as provided in Regulations 42 and 43 hereof and in subclause (2) of this regulation, the Court shall not have regard to any fluctuations in the cost of living ".
