DIESEL OIL AND FUEL OIL) REGULATIONS 1975,  
AMENDMENT NO. 19**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of August 1985

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of August 1985.

**2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of the term “bulk consumer” the expression “200 litres”, and substituting the expression “1,000 litres”.

**3. Maximum prices increased**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 18), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

**4. Revocation**—Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 18 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 15 August 1985, reduce by 5c per litre the maximum prices that may be charged for automotive diesel oil. The retailer's margin is increased by 1c per litre.

In addition, these regulations amend the definition of the term "bulk consumer". Under the principal regulations, as made in 1975, a "bulk consumer" is a person who purchases automotive diesel oil in lots of 200 litres or more. Under the principal regulations, as amended by these regulations, a "bulk consumer" is a person who purchases automotive diesel oil in lots of 1,000 litres or more.

The prices for automotive diesel oil include the local authorities petroleum tax. Special provision is made in the principal regulations in respect of the price of automotive diesel oil sold in the Chatham Islands.

The prices of fuel oils are not changed.
