Pursuant to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 17th day of May 1979.
- 2. Maximum prices increased—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 3. Revocation—The Economic Stabilisation (Prices of Automotive Diesel Oil and Fuel Oil) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3, are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 17 May 1979, increase the maximum prices that may be charged for automotive diesel oil and for certain fuel oils under certain classes of sale.

In the case of automotive diesel oil, the price increases are as follows:

Mode of Sale	Present Price per Litre	Increase	New Price per Litre
By wholesaler to retailer	16.2c	1c	17.2c
Sales to bulk consumers	16.5c	1c	17.5c
Delivered for home heating	16.7c	2.5c	19.2c
Retail ex pump or drum	17.2c	2c	19.2c

The prices for automotive diesel oil include the local authorities petroleum tax. Special provision is made in the principal regulations in respect of the price of automotive diesel oil sold in the Chatham Islands.

In the case of the fuel oils, the maximum prices are increased by 1c per litre.

^{*}Prices for sales in drums are for delivery at vendor's premises. Delivery elsewhere in drums may be charged extra for actual costs of delivery.
