**THE ECONOMIC STABILISATION (CONSERVATION OF
PETROLEUM) NOTICE 1974**

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Notice 1974

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Electrical supply authorities to be essential users for purposes of regulations—The Second Schedule to the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974* (as added by regulation 5 of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1)† is hereby amended by inserting, after item 2, the following item:

“2A. An employee of the New Zealand Electricity Department or of an Electrical Supply Authority, within the meaning of section 2 of the Electricity Act 1968, engaged on emergency work being undertaken by that department or Authority.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice provides that an employee of the Electricity Department or of an Electrical Supply Authority, while engaged on emergency work for that department or Authority, is an “essential user” for the purposes of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974.
