THE ECONOMIC STABILISATION (CONSERVATION OF PETROLEUM) NOTICE (NO. 2) 1974

Pursuant to the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Notice (No. 2) 1974.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Restricted periods—The First Schedule to the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974* (as added by regulation 5 of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1†) is hereby amended by deleting the restricted period specified in that Schedule, and by adding the following item:

"The continuous period commencing at 12 o'clock noon on each Saturday and ending at 7 a.m. on the following Monday (except the period commencing at 12 o'clock noon on Saturday the 13th day of April 1974 and ending at 7 a.m. on Monday the 15th day of April 1974)."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this notice is to provide that the Easter weekend will not be a restricted period under the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974 for the sale of motor spirits.
