**THE ECONOMIC STABILISATION (CONSERVATION OF  
PETROLEUM) REGULATIONS 1974, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 1st day of May 1974

Present:

THE HON. M. A. CONNELLY PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Revocation of regulations imposing restricted periods for sale of motor spirits**—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1), is hereby further amended by revoking the definition of the terms “authorised retailer”, “Commissioner”, “essential user”, and “restricted period”.

(2) The principal regulations (as amended by regulation 4 of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1) are hereby further amended by revoking regulations 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 11.

(3) The First, Second, and Third Schedules to the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 5 of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1) are hereby revoked.

**3. Consequential revocations**—(1) Regulation 5 of the Economic Stabilisation (Conservation of Petroleum) Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 1\*, and the Schedule to those regulations, are hereby consequentially revoked.

(2) The following notices are hereby consequentially revoked:
