ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of May 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Expiry of principal regulations**—Regulation 2 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “31st day of May”, and substituting the words “30th day of September”.

**3. Price of protein-enriched bread increased**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## MAXIMUM WHOLESALE AND RETAIL PRICES OF PROTEIN-ENRICHED BREAD

## PART I

*If not bakehouse wrapped*

	Wholesale Price	Retail Price
Per loaf weighing not less than 1 lb 8 oz .....	23c	26c
Per loaf weighing less than 1 lb 8 oz but not less than 1 lb .....	17c	20c

## PART II

*If bakehouse wrapped (whether sliced or unsliced)*

	Wholesale Price	Retail Price
Per loaf weighing not less than 1 lb 8 oz .....	26c	29c
Per loaf weighing less than 1 lb 8 oz but not less than 1 lb .....	20c	23c".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations continue in force, until the close of the 30th day of September 1976, the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976 (which were to have expired with the close of the 31st day of May 1976).

These regulations also effect a 1 cent a loaf increase in the maximum price of protein-enriched bread.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 27 May 1976.
