ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of August 1976.

**2. Price of bread increased**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule and the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the First and Second Schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 and the Schedule to the Economic Stabilisation (Bread Prices) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, are hereby consequentially revoked.
