**THE EDUCATION (AREA SCHOOLS) REGULATIONS 1986,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE HON. R. O. DOUGLAS PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (Area Schools) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Area Schools) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Positions of responsibility—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in any regulations made under the Act, every person who, immediately before the commencement of these regulations, was the senior teacher at an area school receiving the senior administrative allowance shall, on that commencement, become the Deputy Principal of that school.

3. Powers and responsibilities of Deputy Principal—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 41, the following regulation:

“41A. Subject to the general direction of the Board, the Deputy Principal of an area school shall have the powers and responsibilities of the Deputy Principal of a secondary school.”

These regulations provide for the appointment of deputy principals in area schools. The senior teacher at any area school receiving the senior administrative allowance becomes its deputy principal on the commencement of these regulations.
